



## UNIFORM POLICY

For the following reasons, it is essential that each child wears a uniform:

- A sense of belonging
- A feeling of equality
- Mutual growth
- Student safety
- Comfort and freedom of movement
- To guard from soiling clothing
- To save on clothing
- Neatness and cleanliness

Uniforms are available in three sizes – “small”, “medium” and “large”. They are made to fit over the children’s clothing and should be neat and in good condition. Names should be clearly printed on the pockets with indelible ink or embroidered on. For example:

Please note that suspenders or overalls worn underneath make bathroom visits complicated. Rubber soled tennis shoes are preferable for daily wear.

### **Student supplies and items to bring on the first day**

Each child will have his/her own ‘cubby’ for storing personal belongings. Please bring the following items on the first day of school:

- A complete change of clothes stored in a zip lock bag or a small sealed plastic container (underclothes, socks, play clothes etc.). Please ensure clothing is changed at the beginning of winter and summer to accommodate for the change of temperature and it is clearly labelled.
- A box of tissues
- A large roll of paper towels e.g. Kleenex Viva 11”
- A bottle of mosquito spray
